Royal Towns and Delight on the Wine Route

Absolutely unique – a completely preserved castle from the 13th century, the Červený Kameň Castle! Explore the ambience and pomp of the seat of the Pálffy House, learn how the noble lived, watch a spectacular fencing duel or visit the falcon grounds. Permanent exhibitions and the mysterious renaissance underground are accompanied by many events and festivals all year round. On the way through the picturesque wine-growing landscape, we recommend visiting the modern Etesko wine complex with unusual architecture and the Zoya Museum, where you will also meet the work of Andy Warhol. Visit the vineyards and wine cellars of the royal towns of Modra, Pezinok and Svätý Jur on the Small-Carpathian Wine Route. Taste the bustling goose with foies gras in the Kingdom of the Goose (Kráľovstvo Husaciny) in Slovenský Grob. Your next destination should be the observation tower at the top of Veľká Homola or any of the marked walking and cycling trails in the Small Carpathians. If you need some Rest&Relax after that, wellness facilities and a good sleep and gourmet experience within the heart of nature can be found at Zochova chata Hotel, Hotel pod Lipou in Modra-Harmónia or at the brand-new Palace Art Hotel in a reconstructed chalet in Pezinok.

Cycling Trip for History and Nature Lovers

The historic mansions of the Pálffy family, we recommend and the Mariánka pilgrimage site directly below the forests of Záhorie make the region suitable for relaxation of body and soul. The castle ruins of the Plavecký Castle and Pajštún Castle will enchant you with their atmosphere. You will get to know the unique nature of the Morava River thanks to the educational bicycle path on the Eurovelo 13 route, which will take you to the national monument of Devín Castle. Visit the historic tower at Skalica, swim on the Bata canal, admire the synagogue in Malacky, where in the past it was read from the Torah and where today there is a concert hall and art studio. Would you believe that you will find such a unique thing in Malacky as a copy of the holy stairs from Rome?

GETTING TO THE CITY CENTRE
From M.R. Štefánik Airport: bus 61 – get off at the Hlavná stanica stop – change to bus 93 (get off at the Hodžovo námestie stop) or change to tram 1 (get off at the Centrum stop); bus 61 – get off at the Trnavské myto stop – change to trams 4 (get off at the Poštová stop), or 9 (get off at the Poštová stop).
From Hlavná stanica Railway Station: bus 93 (get off at the Hodžovo námestie stop) or tram 1 (get off at the Centrum stop).
From Petržalka Railway Station: buses 80 and 93 (get off at the Zochova stop)
From Bus Station Nivy: trolleybus 60 or 72 (get off at the Rajská stop).
From Vienna Airport/Schwechat: regular shuttle buses to the city centre and also to the bus station and M.R. Štefánik Airport

TAXI
It is less expensive to order a taxi over the phone than to hire a taxi from a taxi stand or stop a taxi on the street. The minimum charge for a short-distance trips is around €5. We recommend checking the price with the driver prior to getting in the vehicle. Every taxi must have a price list displayed in a visible location, and a fare meter must be used.

Day services: buses, trams and trolleybuses run from 04.30 to 23.30
Night services: buses run from 23.30 to 4.30 and are labelled with the letter "N" followed by a line number

tickets:
• single multiple-ride ticket valid for 30 or 60 minutes
• day multiple-ride ticket valid for 24, 72 or 168 hours
• children up to 6 years of age travel for free
• children from 6 to 18 years (6.0 to 17.99 years) discounted travel
• ticket for oversized luggage, bicycles and pets – discounted 30-minute ticket with a prolonged three-hour validity for all IDS BK zones (not valid on trains)
• mobile ticket via app IDS BK (Android, iOS, Huawei)
Passengers are required to buy tickets in the ticket machines available at the stops, at news-paper stands or at the DPB – City Transportation Company shops before getting on board. Immediately after boarding the first vehicle, passengers must stamp their tickets in the nearest stamping machine. An unstamped ticket is invalid. Passengers who are unable to present a valid ticket during a ticket inspection are fined according to the current Conditions of Carriage.

- 1 BRATISLAVA CASTLE**
The former seat of the rulers, today the symbol of Bratislava and the seat of the Museum of History. There is a wonderful view of the city and the neighbouring countries from its 47-metre-high crown tower in which royal coronation jewels used to be deposited.
- 2 ST. MARTIN'S CATHEDRAL**
A three-nave Gothic church from the 15th century and the former coronation church. A gilded replica of the coronation crown fixed on the top of the cathedral tower at a height of 85 metres and weighing 150 kg reminds of this glorious age.
- 3 OLD TOWN HALL**
The former seat of the city self-government since 1868 the seat of the Bratislava City Museum, the oldest museum in Slovakia. After climbing up the narrow stairs leading to its 45-metre-high tower you will be rewarded with a beautiful panoramic view of the Old Town.
- 4 PRIMATE'S PALACE**
A Classicist palace built in the 18th century in which the Peace of Pressburg was agreed after Napoleon's victory at the Battle of Austerlitz. The Palace houses a gallery depositing a unique collection of six English tapestries from the 17th century.
- 5 EUROVEA WATERFRONT**
The combination of the promenade, the Eurovea shopping center, the Danube riverside and the Slovak National Theatre is an exceptional urban element. Here you can also find many cafés and restaurants or relax on the Danube riverbank.



- 6 GRASSALKOVICH PALACE**
A Rococo summer palace from the 18th century used to be known for its rich social life and a famous composer Joseph Haydn also performed here. Since 1996 it serves as the seat of the President of the Slovak Republic.
- 7 BLUE CHURCH**
The St. Elizabeth's church built in the Art Nouveau style at the beginning of the 20th century is remarkable for the blue colour of its facade made with attention to detail with often use of mosaic. It is a popular place for weddings and baptisms.
- 8 SLAVÍN**
The largest war memorial in Central Europe is thanks to its height of 52 metres one of the dominating features of the city skyline. It is the burial ground of 6845 soldiers of the Soviet army who died during the liberation of Bratislava in World War II.
- 9 DEVÍN CASTLE**
A castle ruin built on a high rock towering above the confluence of the Danube and Morava rivers is one of the most important historical and archaeological localities in Central Europe. Moreover, it offers enchanting natural scenery with unrepeatable views.
- 10 UFO-AUSSICHTSTURM**
Einzigartige Aussichtsplattform auf den Pfeilern der Brücke Most SNP in einer Höhe von 95 Metern mit erstaunlicher Aussicht auf die Stadt und mit einer Fernsicht bis zu 100 km. Sie bietet den schönsten Sonnenuntergang in Bratislava in Kombination mit einem kulinarischen Erlebnis.
