THE CHOIR PURCELL AND THE ORCHESTER ORFEO - opening concert under the baton of György Vashegyi

Under the baton of the conductor, laureate of the F. Liszt Prize and Associate Professor György Vashegyi, several major operas, oratorios, cantatas and orchestral programs were born. Štefan Holčík: Streets and squares of the historic city center, buildings and personalities

The historic city center of the former Pressburg / Pozsony / Prešpork is located in a triangle defined by SNP Square, Hviezdoslav Square and Jewish (or Old Town Street) Street, which is not a street per se but rather a road leading to the bridge. There are about 15 streets in the area, three spaces with a modern name "square" which originally served as market places, and one place at the site of the former cemetery and demolished house, which also bears the name "square". Today's street network reflects its origins - the end of the 12th century. Thousands of residents have lived here over the course of eight hundred years. Most of them were buried close to the parish church and yet still remain anonymous. Only now and then you hear about some personalities who have changed the city's life.
