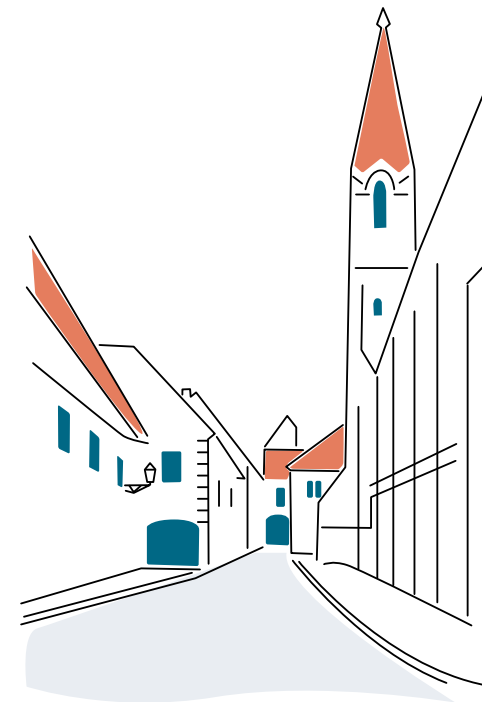

Good to know

How to get to Bratislava

BY PLANE

BRATISLAVA Airport (BTS)

The airport in Bratislava is accessible from the centre in 15-20 min. It has direct connections with many destinations in Europe, various airlines fly here - Ryanair, Wizz Air, Smartwings and more. From the airport you can get to the centre by bus or taxi. www.bts.aero

VIENNA-SCHWECHAT Airport (VIE).

Vienna Airport is only 50 km westward from Bratislava and is another gateway to Slovakia. Buses to Bratislava leave at half-hourly to hourly intervals. Tickets are purchased online via the carrier's website or directly with the bus driver (only in case of free places). www.viennaairport.com

BY TRAIN

The main routes are from Prague, Budapest, Vienna and other parts of Slovakia. The city has several railway stations, which are well connected by the public transport. Trams, buses and trolleybuses run from the Central Station to the entire

BY BUS

Bratislava has a convenient bus connection to many European cities and other regions of Slovakia. Connections arrive at Nivy Bus Station. www.slovaklines.sk, www.regiojet.sk, www.flixbus.sk

BY SHIP

Thanks to its location on the Danube river, Bratislava has a regular boat connection with Vienna. The centre of Vienna (Schwedenplatz) and Bratislava are connected by a fast catamaran Twin City Liner, but also by another speed boat, which moors in Vienna on Handelskai. In the season you can also reach the tourist destinations Devín and Čunovo by boat. www.lod.sk, www.twincityliner.sk

BY CAR

Bratislava is located in Schengen area at the junction of important motorways. Prague is 324 km, Budapest 196 km, Vienna 62 km from the city. Toll stickers

can be bought online, at the border or at petrol stations. The shortest sticker validity is 10 days.

How to travel in Bratislava

PUBLIC TRANSPORT BC

Public transport in Bratislava is part of the Integrated Transport System in the Bratislava Region, which also includes regional buses and suburban trains.

Daily services: buses, trams and trolleybuses from 04:30 to 23:30

Night services: buses from 23:30 to 04:30, services are marked with letter N and line number

Travel tickets:

- tickets valid for 30 or 60 minutes
- SMS tickets valid for 40 minutes, 70 minutes or 24 hours
- daily tickets valid for 24, 72 or 168 hours
- children under 6 years – free transport, children from 6 to 18 years – students (including foreign students with a valid ISIC card) – discounted ticket
- seniors over 70 and disabled persons – discounted ticket
- The passenger is obliged to buy their ticket from: vending machines at the stops; newspaper stands, kiosks or

by using an online application before boarding the vehicle. At their first boarding the passenger must mark the ticket in the nearest ticket punch. Unmarked tickets are invalid. A passenger who fails to present a valid ticket to an inspector is obliged to pay a fine at the amount of tariff determined by the current transport regulation.

CAR RENTAL

Bratislava offers the possibility to rent a car through international companies such as Hertz, Avis, Sixt or Europcar. Their branches can usually be found in large hotels or at the airport. In the city, however, you will find local car rental companies that offer similarly quality services at comprehensive prices.

PARKING

On the main streets of the city centre there are signboards indicating the current number of parking vacancies in underground car parks or parking lots. Street parking fee can be paid via SMS (local providers), by using an online application parkdots, or by purchasing a card in the parking machine. Payment is due on business days from 8:00 to 18:00.

TAXI

It is preferable to book a taxi by phone rather than use the services of a fixed stand, or stop a cab on the street. The minimum fare for short distances is around 5 EUR. We recommend checking the price before boarding the vehicle. Every taxi vehicle must have the price list installed in a visible place and use a taxi-meter. It is advantageous to order a taxi by using an online application.

ON FOOT OR BY BICYCLE

The advantage of Bratislava is the compactness of the city centre, so most of its key attractions can be reached on foot or with a use of bike sharing – a shared system of stations with yellow or pink bicycles.

Travel documents and visas

Slovakia is part of the Schengen area and allows visa-free entry to the country for citizens of the European Union with a valid passport or ID card. Foreigners subject to a visa requirement are obliged to submit a visa application to the local embassy of the Slovak Republic or to the Consulate General. Visas are not issued at the places of arrival (airport, port, etc.). www.mzv.sk

Time zone and weather

Slovakia is located in the Central European Time Zone. Summer time is also used in the country, when the time is shifted one hour ahead in April and returned in October. Slovakia is situated in the northern mild climate zone. The average daily temperature in summer (July, August) reaches 21 °C (maximum 38 °C), in winter (December, January) - 1 °C (minimum - 20 °C).

Language

The official language is Slovak, which belongs to the Slavic languages and is similar to Czech and Polish. In Bratislava you can communicate in English, but also other foreign languages are often used.

ELECTRICITY

220 V / 50 Hz, standard European sockets with safety pin.

PHONE / INTERNET

International dialling code for Slovakia is 00421 and call prefix for Bratislava 02. Free wireless WiFi connection (Visit-Bratislava) is available in the city centre and free access to the Internet is also available in hotels, cafes, restaurants and some institutions.

CURRENCY AND BANKING SERVICES

The official currency in Slovakia is EURO (€). Foreign currencies can be

exchanged in banks, exchange offices and hotels. Credit cards (American Express, Diners Club, Visa and Eurocard / Master-Card) and debit cards (Maestro and VisaElectron) are commonly accepted. Cash can be withdrawn from ATMs. Banks are generally open Monday to Friday from 9:00 to 17:00, on Saturdays from 9:00 to 12:00, in shopping malls daily according to the opening hours of the mall.

Sights and attractions

Bratislava belongs to the group of smaller capital cities with a charming and compact centre, where you can find the most popular sights within walking distance. Historic buildings are a testimony to its glorious ancient history and coexist with modern architecture and the benefits of the modern world.

From the past ...

The city centre possesses the atmosphere of ancient times, the streets are lined with impressive historic buildings, splendid palaces, impressive townhouses and dignified sacral monuments that have stood in their places for centuries and witnessed everyday life and festive moments of the city. Nowadays, several architectural monuments serve the public as museums, galleries, theatres and concert halls, cultural institutions and schools.

... to the future

Modern buildings adapted to the

requirements of contemporary society also turn up constantly on Bratislava's map. Multifunctional complexes, modern shopping centres, office buildings and residential towers are prominent landmarks of the city with an unmistakable design, modern architecture, but also with green relaxation zones. Some have an attractive location on the banks of the Danube River where you can also find the project of the highly influential architect Zaha Hadid. The most known modern buildings are: Eurovea, River Park, Danubiana M. Art Museum, National Bank of Slovakia, Panorama City, Zuckerman, Sky

Park, Twin City, new building of the Slovak National Theatre.

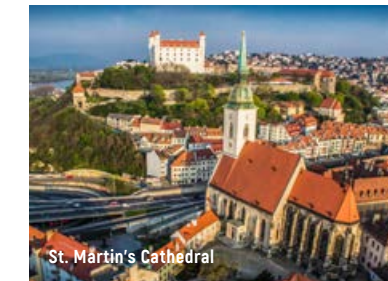
TOP 10 MONUMENTS

Bratislava Castle BC

Originally the residence of monarchs, today the symbol of Bratislava and the seat of the Museum of History (SNM). From its 47-metre-high crown tower, where the royal crown jewels were kept, you can enjoy a breathtaking view of the city and its surroundings.

St. Martin's Cathedral

Gothic three-nave church from the

are among the most photographed attractions and popular "selfie" spots of the city.

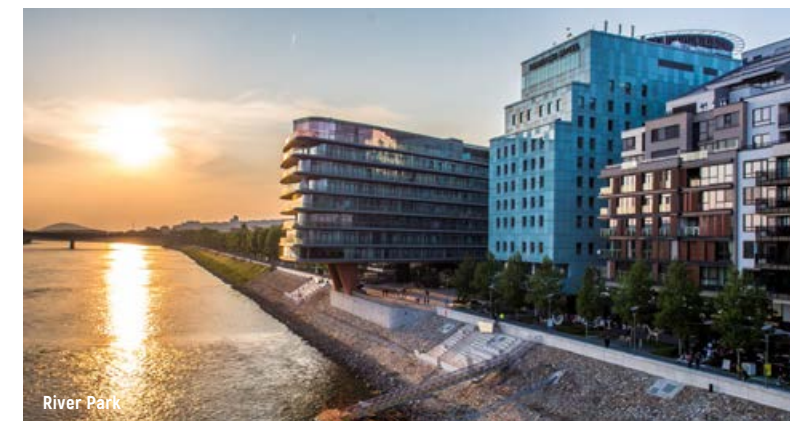
15th century, former coronation cathedral. A reminder of these glorious times is the gold-plated replica of the coronation crown weighing 150 kg and set on top of the cathedral tower at a height of 85 metres.

Old Town Hall BC

Originally the residence of the municipal government, since 1868 the home of the Bratislava City Museum, the oldest museum in Slovakia. You will enjoy stunning panoramic views of Old Town from the top of the 45-metre high 700-year-old tower.

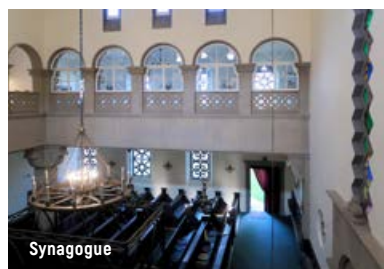
Primate's Palace BC

Classicist palace from the 18th century. After the victory of Napoleon in the Battle of Austerlitz, the representatives of the French and Austrian emperors signed here the Treaty of Pressburg. At present there is a gallery exhibition holding a unique collection of 6 English tapestries from the 17th century and is

the seat of the Mayor of the city.

Michael's Gate BC

The only preserved fortification gate from the 14th century. From the upper terrace of its 51-metre-high tower, you can enjoy stunning views of the Old Town. Nowadays the tower houses the Museum of Arms.

Blue Church

Art Nouveau style St. Elizabeth's Church from the early 20th century is characterized by its blue colour, fine detailed work on its facade with frequent use of mosaic decoration.

The castle ruin on the high cliff towering over the confluence of the rivers Danube and Morava on the Slovak-Austrian border area is among the most important historical and archaeological sites in Central Europe. Moreover, it offers charming natural scenery with fantastic views.

Grassalkovich Palace

The 18th-century Rococo Palace was known for its rich social life including concerts by the famous Joseph Haydn. Since 1996 it has been the residence of the President of Slovakia.

Synagogue BC

The synagogue was built in the Cubist style in the years 1923 - 1926 according to a design by architect Artur Szalattai-Slatinský. The permanent exhibition of the Jewish Community Museum is open to the public during the summer season.

Slavín

The largest war memorial in Central Europe. Nearly 7,000 Soviet Army soldiers who fell during the liberation of Bratislava are buried in its memorial park.

UFO Observation deck

On the bridge at a height of 95 metres.

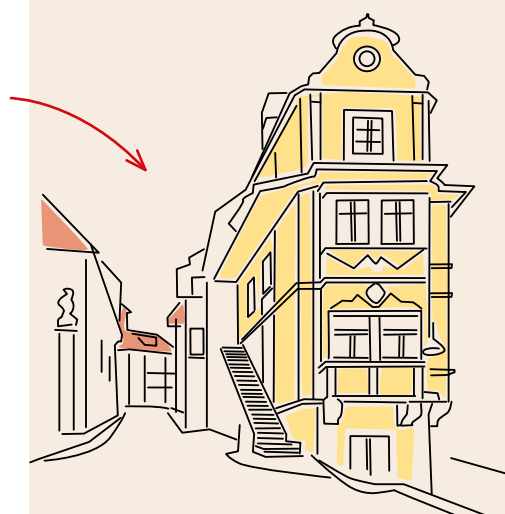

Marvellous panoramas

The charm of the city and its dominant buildings is best seen as a bird's eye view from the tops of the neighbouring hills, lookout terraces and towers of historic buildings. An alternative view of the city also opens up from the deck of a boat cruising the Danube River.



Along the Danube riverbank

Bratislava is often called the Beauty on the Danube. This European river giant is a refreshing part of the city centre. The promenade on both banks is good for pleasant walks, jogging or a relaxing seat in a cafe or on the lawns with romantic river views.

On the Danube

Sightseeing cruises under the Bratislava bridges are a good choice for a comfortable tour of Bratislava's main landmarks from a slightly different perspective. Devin Castle proudly towering over the confluence of the Danube

and Morava rivers is also accessible by the river. In the high season there are boat trips to Čunovo, to the Museum of Modern Art - a compelling gallery on the Danube peninsula. The Danube also connects Bratislava with Austria and Hungary, tourists especially enjoy the regular return cruises between Vienna and Bratislava. It is possible to rent vessels for special cruises, family, corporate and social events to enjoy exceptional moments with extraordinary panoramic views.

City from above

The highest point of Bratislava is the

Devínska Kobyla hill at 514 metres above sea level. The tallest building in Bratislava is the Kamzik TV Tower, which rises to a height of almost 200 metres on the Kamzik Hill (439 metres above sea level) in the Koliba forest park. Its attraction is the rotating restaurant in the tower which offers a 360 degrees panoramic view. There is a smaller but more natural alternative to enjoy the most beautiful sights of Bratislava from a wooden lookout tower on a nearby meadow called American Square. Closer to the city at a height of 52 metres is the largest war memorial in Central Europe, where

you can see the city in the palm of your hand. The most popular sightseeing place in the historical centre is the courtyard of Bratislava Castle. During a tour of the Old Town we recommend you to overcome your fear of heights or laziness and climb the stairs of the Old Town Hall tower and Michael's Tower, from where you can enjoy wonderful views of the streets and squares, colourful roofs and dominant landmarks. The unlimited horizon also opens up from the high cliff where the Devin ruins soar at the confluence of the Danube and Morava rivers.



UFO on the Danube

The lookout tower with a restaurant on a Danube bridge resembling a UFO is one of the symbols of the capital city. The UFO tower is 95 m high and offers visitors views over the neighbouring countryside within a 100 km radius.

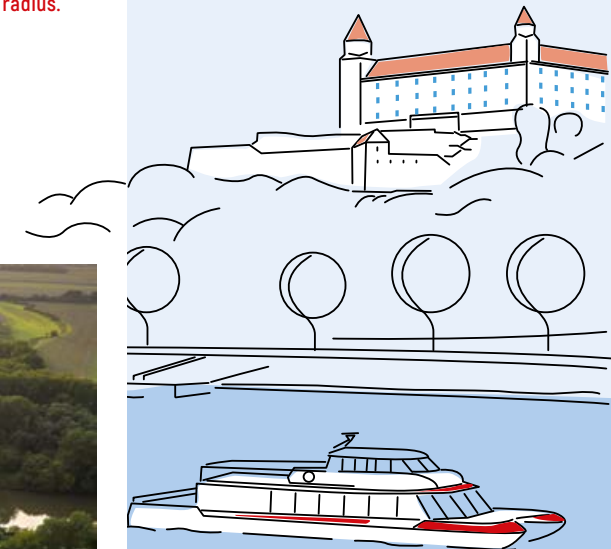

From fossils to modern art

The treasures of the town's history and unique thematic collections are exhibited in almost 40 museums and art works of various formats and styles are provided by twenty galleries. Many of them are based in historical palaces in Bratislava's historical centre.

Exposed past

You can trace the city's past in the City History Museum at the Old Town Hall and in the nearby Apponyi Palace where the Museum of Historic Interiors is based. Fans of the ancient excavations will come into their own at the Archaeological Museum under the castle or in Rusovce, where the remains of a Roman military camp can be seen. Museum Ancient Gerulata as part of "Limes Romanus", awaits inclusion in the UNESCO World Heritage register. The multiculturalism of Bratislava is also presented by museums of culture of ethnic groups - Carpathian Germans,

Hungarians, Croats and Jews.

To the castle!

Exhibitions at Bratislava Castle show the history of the territory of Slovakia. Descend into the cellars and admire artefacts in the treasury or climb up to the Coronation Tower, where the Crown Jewels were once stored. Another castle is only 20 minutes away from the centre. Devin Castle is a ruin after destruction by Napoleonic troops, situated on a high rock above the confluence of two rivers. You can also have an excursion into the countryside to Červený Kameň Castle, where you

can admire the aristocracy's residential architecture and the largest historical cellars in Central Europe.

Collections for all interests

Specialized thematic museums offer interesting exhibitions. The clock collection is housed in a narrow Rococo house. Weapons are displayed in Michael's Tower. On the list there are also exhibits of the Museum of Pharmacy, Natural History Museum or the collection of veteran vehicles at the Museum of Transport. Fans of military history are welcomed in army bunkers, wine enthusiasts can enjoy wine-tast-

ing at the Museum of Viticulture at the Apponyi Palace or admire the largest collection of wine presses on the continent at the Small Carpathian Museum in Pezinok.

Colours and forms

The rich collections of art from Gothic to contemporary creations are presented in galleries. A pleasant café in the Slovak National Gallery in Esterházy Palace makes the artistic experience even more agreeable. The Bratislava City Gallery exhibits its treasures at the Mirbach and Pálffy Palaces. The greatest attraction of the Primate's

The Danube Peninsula in Čunovo offers a symbiosis of art works and natural scenery at the Museum of Modern Art Danubiana.

Palace is a collection of six 17th-century English tapestries depicting an ancient mythological theme. The interior of the Nedbalka Gallery resembles the Guggenheim Museum in New York and the ÚLUV Gallery provides space for artefacts of traditional crafts and folk-art design.

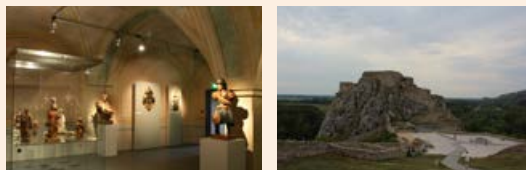

On the wings of music

In the past, the city hosted several music giants. To commemorate them there are plaques on the walls of palaces. The city is full of cultural events throughout the year, which you can enjoy in the historic interiors of the theatre and the philharmonic, but also right in the city streets.

Visits of musical geniuses

Compositions by famous representatives of classical music were played in the houses of the Bratislava aristocrats, sometimes even by the composers themselves. In 1762 the six-year-old W. A. Mozart played a concerto on Ventúrska Street and Franz Liszt performed where the University Library is based today. Ludwig van Beethoven also visited Bratislava. Joseph Haydn performed as a conductor for Count Nicholas I. Esterházy in his palace on Kapitúlská Street and in 1772 he also conducted the orchestra at a ball in the Grassalkovich Palace on the occasion

of the marriage of Maria Christina, daughter of Maria Theresa.

Museum from a family house

Music composer, pianist and conductor Johann Nepomuk Hummel was born in Bratislava and is author of several operas, piano concertos and masses. He received basic music education from W. A. Mozart, cooperated with J. Haydn and was a concert master in the orchestra of Count M. Esterházy. Russian pianist and composer Anton Rubinstein played a memorable concert in Bratislava and the profits were used to build a J. N. Hummel memorial.

In the Renaissance garden house on Klobučnícka Street where Hummel was born in 1778, a museum was established, where you can find fragments of his musical notation and a collection of musical instruments.

Exceptional art in spectacular space

High-quality performances, magic melodies, world-class performers and a rich repertoire also deserve exceptional spaces. The historical building of the Slovak National Theatre and Reduta, the home of the Slovak Philharmonic, is a landmark in Hviezdoslav Square.

The new building of the Slovak National Theatre on the Danube embankment is also a remarkable architectural work, but of a modern look. Choose from opera, ballet, drama and classical music concerts and combine an artistic experience with a tour of the interior.

Festivals of different genres

Every musical genre can be found at the Bratislava's music festivals. These events are held regularly every year and have an international flavour. For enthusiasts of the classics we recommend first-class events such as Bratislava Music Festival, Convergen-

ces, Viva Musica!, Bratislava Jazz Days, whilst for followers of other music styles there is Uprising reggae, World Music Festival, Advent and Christmas Music Festival, and there are also guitar, organ, choir and folklore festivals.



Three months of culture

The Cultural Summer and Castle Festival Bratislava is a series of multi-genre programs for various interests in the streets of the city. The biggest summer cultural festival of the capital, full of concerts and performances.

Thematic tours

Requests for the tour must be registered at least 2 hours in advance. With the Bratislava Card the tour is free. Itinerary of the hour tour: Primate's (Primaciálne) Square - Courtyard of Old Town Hall - Main (Hlavné) Square - Františkánske Square - Biela Street - Michalská Street - Michael's

Gate - Ventúrska Street - Panská Street - Rudnay Square. The Tourist Information Centre of BTB, as well as other tour operators (see the list on page 64), will provide tours according to individual requirements and for all kinds of interest. We offer Bratislava coronation, post-communist, sacral, Jewish, musical, culinary, wine, beer, green, evening, alternative tours, programs for families and trip to the region. You can discover the city on foot while walking or jogging, by bus, in a tourist train, in a retro car, on boat, on motorboat, by segway or bike.

Coronation Bratislava

Bratislava was once the coronation city of the Kingdom of Hungary. During the years 1563 – 1830, 10 kings, 7 royal wives, and the famous empress Maria Theresa were crowned in St. Martin's Cathedral. In the streets of current Bratislava, you can pass buildings that witnessed the coronation ceremony as part of the authentic procession route marked by brass crowns in the pavement. Every year the royal history comes alive during the Coronation Days along with a historical parade and knights' tournaments.

Programs for children

Families can enjoy interesting museum exhibitions, e.g. Museum of Transport and the Natural History Museum and also magic views from Bratislava and Devín Castles. Children can let off steam in the city parks or in the forest park, where several amusement structures can be found - Chair lift to Kamzík, bobsleigh route or rope park. Animal lovers must see the Bratislava ZOO. Children can play in all weathers in the Jump Arena, visit the adventure science centre Aurelium, illusion gallery Multium composed of mirrors, prepare their own sweets at Bon Manufaktur, and experience creativity at the International House of Art for Children, Bibiana.

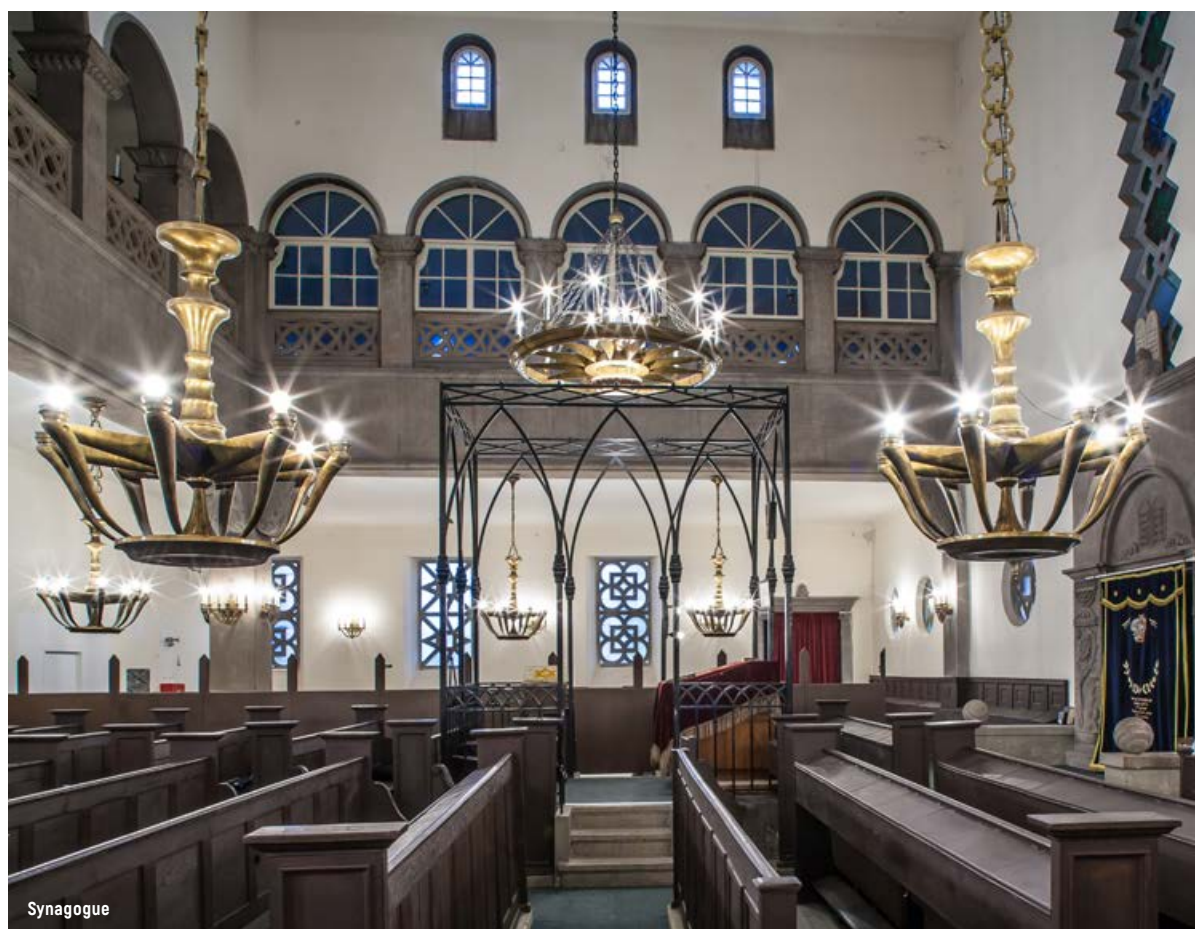

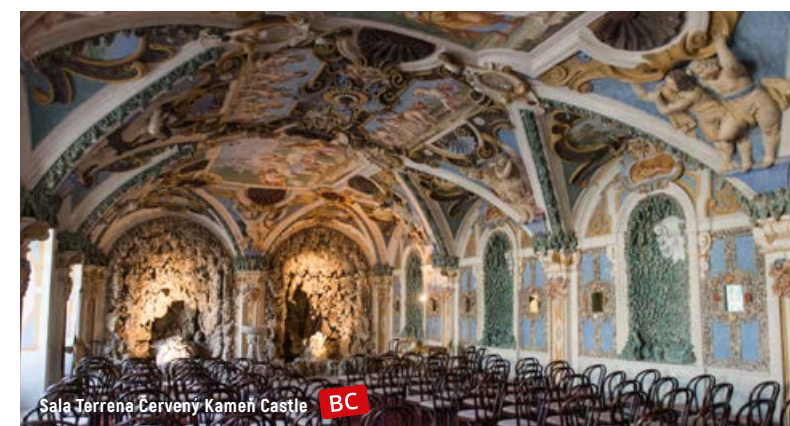
Jewish Bratislava

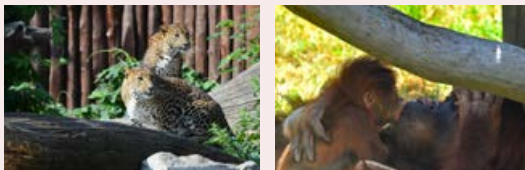

It has 1104 individuals from 185 species under its care. The rarest include the Nubian adax, Visayan wild boar, Sumatran orangutan, Turkmen kulan, golden-faced gibbon, Liberian hippopotamus, and Ceylon leopard. It is also the only zoo in Slovakia where you can find chimpanzees, giraffes and rhinos.

Forest in the city

From the city it is just a short leap into the forest. The Horský Park with its original forest environment boasts a 130-year-old gamekeeper's lodge. A popular leisure location is the Bratislava forest park with a TV Tower on the top of Kamzík hill, which offers a panoramic view from its rotating restaurant. A chair lift operates between the stations of Kamzík and Železná Studnička. A goal of family trips is a bob-sleigh route with near rope park and lovers of natural romance will enjoy two tree-top houses. The protected landscape areas around Devínska

Kobyla and Small Carpathians (Malé Karpaty) create ideal conditions for organized bird-watching and observation of flora and fauna. The Sandberg site of fossils of prehistoric marine life is also very unique.

Parks with a hint of history

The city centre is refreshed by parks whose history dates back to the 18th century. You can spend pleasant time in the city park Sad J. Kráľa - the oldest public park in Central Europe, or in the park Medická záhrada or Botanical Garden. An interesting feature of the Grassekovich Garden at the Presidential

Palace is an avenue of trees planted by heads of state during visits to Slovakia. The baroque garden in the castle was reconstructed according to plans from the reign of Maria Theresa.

Up the tempo!

The green city zones are popular locations for enthusiasts of jogging or running. Take a Go! running city tour or choose from marathons.

On two wheels

Get to know the city by bicycle, take an organized bike tour or rent a yellow city bike. From the city centre you

can connect with two international cycling routes - the Danube (Eurovelo 6) and the Iron Curtain Cycle Route (Eurovelo 13), which run along the rivers Danube and Morava towards Austria or Hungary. Devín Castle and the Danubiana Museum in Čunovo can also be reached by bicycle. For nature lovers we recommend cycling trips in the Small Carpathian Mountains and adrenaline fans can try the downhill track in the Bratislava forest park.

Relax by the water

During the hot days the lakes are the right places to cool down and enjoy

water sports. You can try speedboats, scooters, surfing, water skis, and hydrospeed on several water areas. The recreation area Golden Sands (Zlaté piesky) also offers adrenaline wakeboarding and flyboard. The natural beauty of the Danube river and its dead channels also attract rowers.

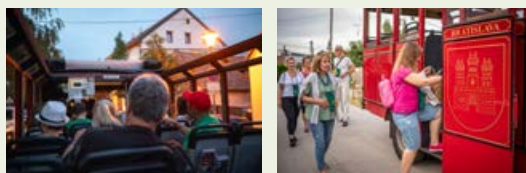

Bratislava has always been a crossroads of different nations. The variety of flavours in Bratislava cuisine is a result of the different ingredients and methods of preparing meals from the time of the Austro-Hungarian Monarchy, mixed with traditional Slovak dishes. The city's culinary experience is further enriched by the wide range of specialties from other parts of the world.

From street-food to a decent dinner with panoramic view

Bratislava offers a wide range of eateries where you can satisfy your hunger, taste the local specialties and spend time in pleasant company. Whether you stop for a snack in a street-food kiosk or enjoy a full-course menu at a fancy restaurant with international cuisine, there is always plenty of options. Have a lunch break in the historical city centre or on the Danube embankment, just a short leap from the interesting tourist sights. Experience tasty dinner with a romantic panoramic view at the UFO tower located on the top of SNP

(Slovak National Uprising) bridge or the popular rotating restaurant at Kamzík TV Tower. Traditional Slovak and local "Prešporok" dishes are to be found on the menu of every good restaurant and many of these are well-known for beer from their own micro-breweries.

Taste the city

The basic ingredients of traditional Slovak cuisine, influenced by a shepherd culture, are potatoes, cabbage and sheep's cheese. Once in Slovakia, you should try original potato gnocchi with "bryndza" (sheep's cheese), pickled sliced cabbage, potato pancakes,

cheese-filled dumplings, bean or a cabbage soup, pork rind biscuits "pagáče" and sweet strudels. The closeness of the river Danube and Hungarian influence is notable in the type of fish dishes whilst you can also order Hungarian goulash or "perkelt" with dumplings. Alternatively, beef sirloin with dumplings and other delicious Czech specialties taste best with a good beer. In addition, there are plenty of places offering Italian or Asian specialties.



Rolls with protected recipe

The most famous speciality and a favourite souvenir from Bratislava is the original Bratislava Roll. In the past, they were even regularly supplied to the Imperial Court in Vienna. Today the European Union has designated them a protected traditional product. They are exclusively handmade according to a prescribed formula without any chemical additives and the surface must be glossy and 'marbled'. There are two kinds of this sweet delicacy - C-shaped with walnut filling or horseshoe-shaped with poppy-seed filling.

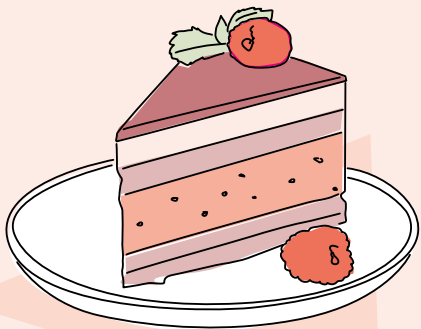

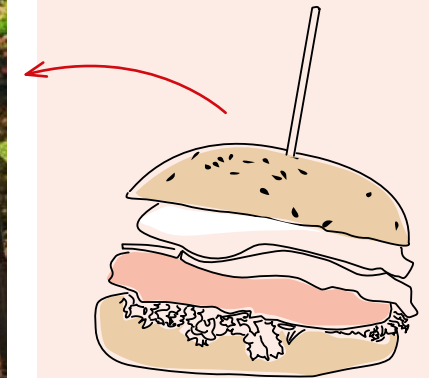

Liquid treasures

Good food also deserves tasty beer or delicious wine. Bratislava is part of the Small Carpathian Wine Region and so in restaurants, wine shops, wine bars and cellars you are also likely to find a selection of wines from local producers. Beer and wine festivals are organized right in the city centre, but it is worthwhile to discover the city surroundings and enjoy wine tasting and wine events throughout entire Small Carpathian region.



Beer

In the city you can choose from several brewery restaurants with their own beer production prepared to the traditional "Prešporok" recipe. In addition to well-known beer brands there is also a boom of small craft breweries that bring unconventional tastes to the beer market. In restaurants, pubs and beer houses there is a wide selection of beer based on its origin, production process, colour and taste. Micro-breweries present their products for public tasting during specialized events. Dozens of craft breweries and hundreds of types of beer accompanied by street

food and entertainment is awaiting the visitors to the Craft Beer Festival - Beer Salon.

A land of delicious wines

The largest viniculture region of Slovakia is located in the vicinity of Bratislava, where grape growing on the hills of the Small Carpathians has a long tradition. White wines such as Grüner Veltliner, Riesling, Chardonnay or the local varieties Devín and Pálava flourish here. Typical red varieties are Frankovka Modrá (Blue Lemberger), Cabernet Sauvignon, Alibernet, Dunaj and Modrý Portugal. The high quality

of wines from the Small Carpathian wine region is demonstrated by the number of international awards achieved in world-wide prestigious wine competitions. The Small Carpathian Wine Route joins together local winemakers and service providers offering an annual programme of events related to viticulture, wine making and wine tasting.

City of Frankovka

In addition to the traditional viniculture towns of the region, such as Pezinok, Modra and Svätý Jur, it should not be forgotten that the capital city has vine-

yards and wine cellars in its suburbs. The Bratislava city district of Rača is famous for its red Blaufränkisch wine, so called Račianska Frankovka. This wine was a favourite drink of the Empress Maria Theresa and could never be left off her table.

Wine celebration

The biggest celebrations of the wine season are the harvesting festivities including wine craft demonstrations, allegorical parades, folk festivals and local wine tasting which are held during September in the towns of Pezinok, Modra and district of Rača.

More winemaking events are: Feast of Young Wine on St. Martin's Days, Open Wine Cellars, Wine and Lavender, A Day in the Vineyards, Ríbezľový Devín – Currant Fruit Wine Festival, Wandering around Bratislava Wine Cellars, Excursion to Rača's Wine Cellars

The speciality of the Devín district is the local currant wine made from black and red currants and called Devínsky ríbezľák.



The Story of wine

The largest collection of wine presses in Europe is situated in the Small Carpathian Museum in Pezinok where you can also test your sense of smell in Aromabar.

Top 100 Slovak wines

You can learn more about the history of the city's vineyards and wine production at the Museum of Viticulture located in the Apponyi Palace. It also includes the National Collection of Wines where you can taste the 100 best Slovak wines.
